## NOMINATION FORM AND COMPLETION INSTRUCTIONS

The " Vanguard Service Awards™ " , are designed to honor men that have shown exceptional community service, public service and/or significant charitable and/or philanthropic contributions of benefit to the community. These awards are given in recognition of these outstanding service efforts to the community, society and humanity as a whole.

This form is to be used to provide relevant data for prospective awardees. The intent is to provide brief, but sufficient information about the nominee in compliance with the criteria and eligibility requirements, that will enabling the Sisters In Service Board members to select the five most qualified nominees.

The five selected honorees, will be informed by January 2, 2017 and a complete personal Bio, with a 3 X 5 " photo will be requested and submitted to Sisters in Service by January 15, 2017. Those nominees not selected as one of the three to be honored, **will** be recognized at the program.

### CRITERIA/ELIGIBILITY

- Nominee must be a male, Colorado state resident.
- Nominees desired from all segments of the community. While they may be associated with specific clubs, churches or other organizations, it is not mandatory that they belong to any formal or special organization/affiliation.
- Nominee must have a broad-based, continuing commitment to community/ public service and /or significant charitable or philanthropic contributions of benefit to the community.
- Nominee should be a devoted advocate of some recognized program or cause, which furthers in some manner the advancement of our youth and/or young adults.
- Nominee must have made or involved in making significant contributions as a volunteer and/or caregiver in the community.
- If selected as one of the five honorees, he must submit a recent photo (at least a 3x5 in size, preferably in color) and a detailed Bio for publication and publicity, that will not be returned.
- If selected as one of the five honorees, he must submit relevant information concerning the recognized charity of your choice to receive the \$100.00 endowment.
